**Class Restrictions:** all specified MSAA Classes are open to adults. Seniors may also participate in any MSAA class but have specifically the classes Senior Freestyle, Senior Freestyle Limited, Senior Bowhunter Freestyle, and Senior Barebow awarded. Young Adults, Youths, and Cubs may participate in Freestyle, Freestyle Limited, Bowhunter Freestyle, Bowhunter Freestyle Limited, and Barebow. Midgets may participate in Freestyle, Freestyle Limited, and Barebow.

**Open Class Registration:** in addition to regular fees if you are participating in the Open Class you must also add a \$30 purse fee. The purse is paid out according to the MSAA Payout Formula.
