

# 2007 Minnesota NASP State Tournament

## Rules & Registration

**Location: Becker High School Field House**

**Date: April 14, 2007**

**Time: 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.**

### Shooting Times:

- 9:00 am
- 11:15 pm
- 1:30 pm
- 3:30 pm Teachers Shoot Off

Shooters must be ready 15 minutes before their assigned shooting time.

### Who may compete

- 1) This tournament is the annual "culminating event" for Minnesota schools participating in the National Archery in the Schools Program (NASP). The basic foundation of NASP is the in-school archery unit. Therefore, schools that teach archery as part of the in-school curriculum any time during the school year are qualified to compete in this tournament. This tournament is not for schools that offer archery only as an after-school activity.
- 2) Cost is \$10.00 / person. Make checks payable to MSAA youth fund.
- 3) Teachers / adult assistants teaching archery in-schools archery unit are invited to participate in Teacher Shoot Off. Teacher Shoot Off will be held ~ 3:30 P.M. while scores are being tabulated.

### Team Event

- 1) Team members must come from a single school, not a school district. Schools may bring maximum of 24 archers per division. Divisions are defined as, Elementary (K–6), Middle School (7–8), High School (9-12). All archers will be competing for individual awards. Individuals can shoot in on an older division team, but will compete as individual in respective division. Example 7<sup>th</sup> grader can compete on high school team, and as individual in middle school division.
- 2) There will be two team divisions. Schools must choose either **National** or **State** Team division. Schools may not participate in both Team Divisions.
  - i. **National** will follow the NASP **National** team size, 12 person teams, with minimum of 4 of opposite gender. Schools participating in National Team will qualify for NASP National Tournament, to be held June 9, 2007, Kentucky State Fairgrounds Convention Center.
    1. Automatic Invitation; 1<sup>st</sup> place team / Division, 1<sup>st</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> place individuals / division
    2. Qualifying Teams; Teams not 1<sup>st</sup> in their division, must achieve following qualifying score, Elementary - 2,500 Middle School - 2,600 High School – 2,700 points to receive invitation to NASP Nationals.
  - ii. To accommodate smaller schools there will be a Minnesota **State** division, 8 person teams, with minimum of 2 of opposite gender.

### Individual Event

- 1) All archers are eligible for individual awards.
- 2) Schools that cannot field a team may participate in tournament for individual awards.

### **Minnesota NASP Team Awards**

- 1) Team awards will be presented for the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> highest scoring **National** teams per division, Elementary (K-6), Middle (7-8), and High School (9-12).
- 2) Team awards will be presented for the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> highest scoring **State** teams per division, Elementary (K-6), Middle (7-8), and High School (9-12).

### **Minnesota NASP Individual Awards**

- 1) Individual awards will be presented 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> highest scoring male and female per division, Elementary (K-6), Middle (7-8), and High School (9-12).

### **Equipment**

- 1) NASP Genesis Compound (target color or camouflage). No sights, tape, marks, or other modifications to the bow that may, in the opinion of the judges be used as a sighting aid. Any marks or tape placed on the riser, above the grip of the bow, inside the sight window, must be removed or the bow will be disqualified. If such a bow is used during the tournament, the archer will be disqualified. Equipment will be inspected.
- 2) Finger tabs, gloves, "no-glove" and armguards may be used.
- 3) No mechanical release aids will be allowed.
- 4) No stabilizers may be attached to the bow.
- 5) Sims vibration devices may be attached to the limbs of the bow but not on the riser.
- 6) Full-length aluminum arrows will be provided by Department of Natural Resources at tournament.

### **Range Set-Up**

- 1) Targets will be 80-cm FITA faces with 10 scoring rings.
- 2) Target butts will be placed directly on the floor to mimic height of school butts.
- 3) Target line will be approximately 5 feet from the target butts.
- 4) There will be 10 and 15 meter shooting lines.
- 5) The waiting line will be 10 feet beyond the 15-meter shooting line.

### **Competition Format**

- 1) Each archer will shoot 1 practice end of 5 arrows at 10 meters followed by 3 ends of 5 arrows (total of 15 shots) at 10 meters for score (150 maximum score). Time limit/end will be 2 minutes beginning with the 1 whistle "shoot" command.
- 2) Each archer will shoot 1 practice end of 5 arrows at 15 meters followed by 3 ends of 5 arrows (total of 15 shots) at 15 meters for score (150 maximum score). Time limit/end will be 2 minutes beginning with the 1 whistle "shoot" command.
- 3) Archers will alternate shooting. Example, line A archers will shoot one end of 5 arrows on 1 whistle "shoot" command, score on 3 whistle command. Line B archers will then shoot one end of 5 arrows on 1 whistle "shoot" command, score on 3 whistle command. Repeat process until all archers have completed 3 ends at 10 meters.
  - a. A and B archers may share bows.
  - b. One bow and set of 5 arrows may be used per 2 archers from a school.
  - c. Two A and two B archers per target.

### **Scoring**

- 1) Adults will be assigned to each elementary division target to keep score. Schools are welcome to bring adult volunteers to help call arrows and keep score. Volunteers will

meet with Tournament Director 30 minutes prior to shooting time for assignments / instructions.

- 2) Arrows touching or cutting a scoring ring line will be given the higher score.

**Judges**

- 1) Will be provided to assist with scoring.
- 2) Inspect equipment for compliance before shooting begins.
- 3) Call disputed arrows (when called upon by adult / middle / high school scorers).
